



CALVIN L. RAMPTON COMPLEX Municipal Project



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- ◆ McNeil Engineering has partnered with the State of Utah Department of Facilities and Construction Management (DFCM) to renovate the site of the Utah Highway Patrol & UDOT campus in Taylorsville, Utah.
- ◆ Conducted in multiple phases over the course of more than four years, McNeil Engineering has been working hand-in-hand with project managers from the DFCM to tear-out and replace the worn and failing asphalt paving at this significant campus. Design goals have included improving existing drainage, reinforcing existing storm water catch basins to better move rainwater and snow melt off of the asphalt surface, and enhancing accessibility for everyone who visits the site. In 2016 McNeil Engineering will be helping to put the final touches on this site and finish out the final phase of asphalt replacement and concrete repair.
- ◆ In addition to the asphalt replacement and miscellaneous concrete repair, McNeil has also provided design and construction oversight for the landscaping and irrigation at the primary entry on the west and in a private courtyard for employees only in the center of the complex.
