





Landscape Architecture Project



ROSEWOOD SKATE PARK Parks & Recreation Project



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- ◆ As a part of an indefinite quantity contract with Salt Lake City Engineering Parks Division, we were commissioned to design a skate park located on the west side of Salt Lake City within the Rose Park area. Our Landscape Architects teamed with Site Design Group, a Skate Park Consultant located in Del Mar California, to create this 20,000 square foot skate park as well as the surrounding site and landscape improvements.
- ◆ The skate park was built on the remains of an outdated tennis court as well as above the northwest drain line. Special design measures were considered in order to minimize disturbance of sub-grade materials to avoid any toxic waste conflicts. The overall design process included meeting with youth groups to collect design ideas, presentation of concepts, design development and then submittal for construction.
- ◆ With a construction budget of \$500,000, the skate park was completed during the Spring of 2007 and continues to be a “hot spot” for skateboard and other extreme sport enthusiasts in the area.



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
