PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- In the spring of 2014, McNeil Engineering was commissioned by the Salt Lake City based architectural firm, NJRA Architects, as the Landscape Architectural consultant for the Intermountain Healthcare Alta View Hospital site and landscape remodel project. This 39-acre campus is located at the corner of 1300 East and 9400 South in Sandy, Utah. Alta View Hospital is in the early stages of a large multi-year remodeling project. Phase one includes the relocation of the main entry road into the site from 9400 South that will transform the weed-filled lot west of the campus into a beautiful new approach road to the hospital. The project will add parking spaces and clear the way for building and service expansion while also helping to beautify the community.
- McNeil's team of Landscape Architects worked closely with NJRA to develop concepts for the new entry road and primary monument signage feature for the campus. In addition, concepts were developed for the steep hillside along 1300 East that would set the tone and character for future expansions. Illustrative renderings and computer-aided 3-dimensional graphics were developed to help convey the design intent to the client. Careful consideration was given to the development of the proposed plant palette and irrigation equipment in an effort to not only conserve water and help reduce maintenance, but to provide seasonal color and texture.
